

PUBLIC HEALTH

08-84 – Disposal of Raw Sewage from Septic Tanks

This bylaw specifies that:

- It is unlawful to deposit raw sewage on any lot or land within the Village of Mistusinne.
- In the fall of each year, for health reasons, the village council shall direct that all septic tanks requiring emptying shall be pumped out at the expense of the owner.

02-03 – Disposal of Domestic Waste

- This bylaw regulates the disposal of household garbage such that:
 - Waste must be in a plastic bag to preclude spillage.
 - Waste must be disposed of only in the receptacles provided.
- No other waste may be deposited in the receptacles, including:
 - Trees or branches,
 - Bulk waste such as construction materials.
 - Metal waste such as appliances, steel fences,
 - Special waste such as batteries, tires, fluorescent light tubes.
- A person who fails to comply with this bylaw shall be liable for a fine of not more than \$500 plus up to \$10 per day until the bylaw has been complied with.

02-06 – Private Residential Off-Site Sand Points

- This bylaw sets out the conditions under which a resident may apply for permission to install an off-site sand point as a source of water to the resident's private dwelling, namely:
- The submission of an application along with a permit fee of \$30 and the issuance of a permit.
- The sand point must be totally buried, including the access pipe, a minimum of one foot below the surface. "Off site" means crown land under lease agreement between the Village and Sask Environment, including but not limited to ditches or easements, but does not include other privately owned property.
- A visual inspection and approval of the open installation site by the Maintenance Worker prior to closing the hole. A final inspection, after installation, to determine that the site has been returned to its original condition
