Emergency Response Committee

- The Emergency Response Committee is:
 - A Standing Committee approved by the Resort Village Council under their Procedure 1.0 of their Procedure Manual, and
 - As such, has an annual budget established by Council,
 - Shall be annually called together by Council,
 - Is comprised of volunteers and includes both the Maintenance Worker and the Greenskeeper,
 - Lead by a coordinator chosen by the committee.

- The main role of the Emergency Response Committee is to provide support to the Elbow Fire Department and the First Responders as follows:
 - To supply water to the Elbow Fire truck in case of a fire in the village.
 - To direct the Elbow fire department and first responders to the source of the emergency.
 - To provide crowd control around the emergency site if needed.
 - Any other areas identified by the Elbow Fire Department and the First Responders.

- Other tasks of the Emergency Response Committee include:
 - Truck and equipment
 - Using the fire truck for monthly practice sessions so as to ensure that the truck is in operating condition, especially during winter months when there is no maintenance personnel in the village,
 - Completing the maintenance log on the truck after its use or servicing,
 - Maintaining the necessary equipment for fire fighting (example – pumps, shovels, gunny sacks, suits, ladder, pails).

 - Coordination with the Elbow Fire Department as needed, including:
 - Assigning a member to meet the Fire Department at the entrance to Mistusinne in the event of a fire.
 - Investigating the possibility of being part of the Elbow fire-phone tree.
 - Providing a map of the village.

- Coordination with the Resort Village Council to:
 - Annually, in the spring, notify Council of the name of the coordinator and the back-up coordinator, along with budget requests for that year.
 - Provide advice to Council on fire safety issues such as fire pits, fireworks, snow removal, fire guards, signs and other issues as identified by the committee.
 - Assist the Resort Village with the annual burn of the brush pile.
 - Have input into the Emergency Response Handout that Council will develop and distribute to all residents in the community.
