

CONSTRUCTION BIN ACCESS

Purpose

Due to the fact that there are ongoing construction projects on a regular basis, Council has deemed it appropriate to have 2 small construction bins within the Resort Village of Mistusinne. One bin shall be designated for small or partial loads only and will be located beside the recycling centre. The other bin shall be designated for large construction projects, billed at \$100, and located beside the other waste containers.

Procedures

Cabin owners who require access to the construction bin are to contact the Village Clerk or the Maintenance Foreman with the names of approved representatives who can access the construction bin on the cabin owner's behalf, if the residents themselves are not going to be present. (i.e. a contractor) The authorized representatives' names will be provided to all Village staff. The cabin owners will be responsible for all charges for using the construction bins.

Use of a full bin:

If a full bin will be required, a key must be obtained from Maintenance personnel or the Village Clerk – *prior to noon on Saturdays*. Residents will be responsible for all the contents of the construction waste bin, and all charges incurred as a result of dumping same bin. When the bin is full, the resident will contact Village staff to let them know that the bin requires dumping and to return the key to the Community Centre or to the Maintenance staff. Access to the Construction Bin will be limited to **1 Week**, to accommodate other residents who also require access to the bin.

Use of a partial bin

For small loads, the Village Clerk, the Administrative Assistant, and the Maintenance person will use their keys to unlock the construction bin for the cabin owner. The amount charged is at the discretion of the Village staff member accepting the construction waste – based on Council's Rate Review. The cabin owner will be billed by the Village Clerk for the portion of the construction bin that was used for their construction waste – for either , , , or full bin.

Only cabin owners and their approved representatives will have access to the construction bin, so as to minimize errors in billing.

Keys for the construction bin locks will be kept in the Community Centre and with the Maintenance Foreman. The recycling clerk will also have a key for the construction bin designated for small construction jobs.

During lake season, the Maintenance foreman will make sure the those construction bins that are full are unlocked for Loraas Disposal in time for the Garbage pick up on Tuesdays.

During the winter season, the Village Clerk will ensure the construction bins are unlocked for Loraas Disposal to empty, if necessary, on Tuesdays.
