



If a similar event was planned for 2024, would you plan to attend?





Did you attend Mistusinne Morning, May long weekend?


















Which beach do you typically use? Please see the attached image for clarification. You may choose up to 2 options.




OTHER:





Other:

- Yes but only if the system can handle it had apt of breakdowns before not so bad this year



Do you feel our council should focus more on bylaw







How often do you feel bylaw inspections should be scheduled

Which bylaws do you feel are the most important to focus on? (select all that apply)






