

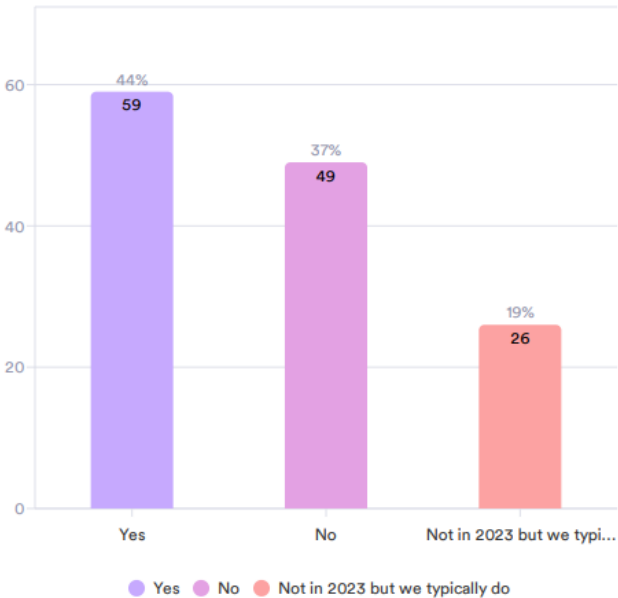

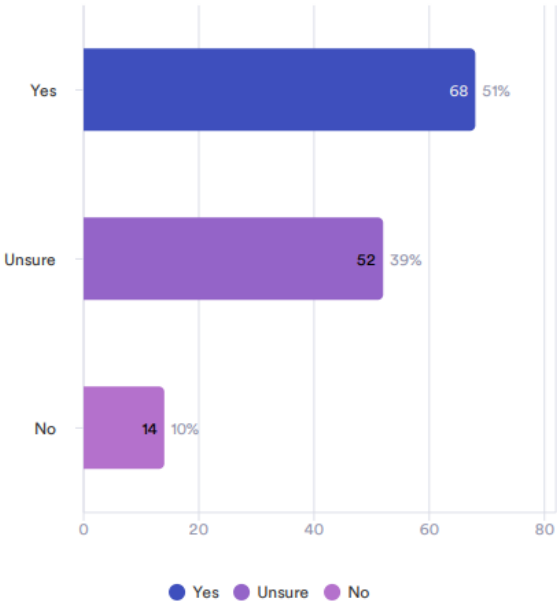
Did you attend the Canada Day festivities?

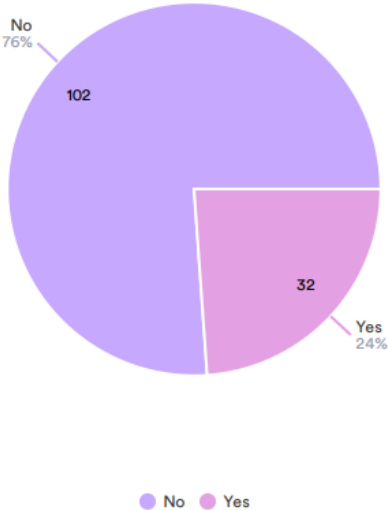

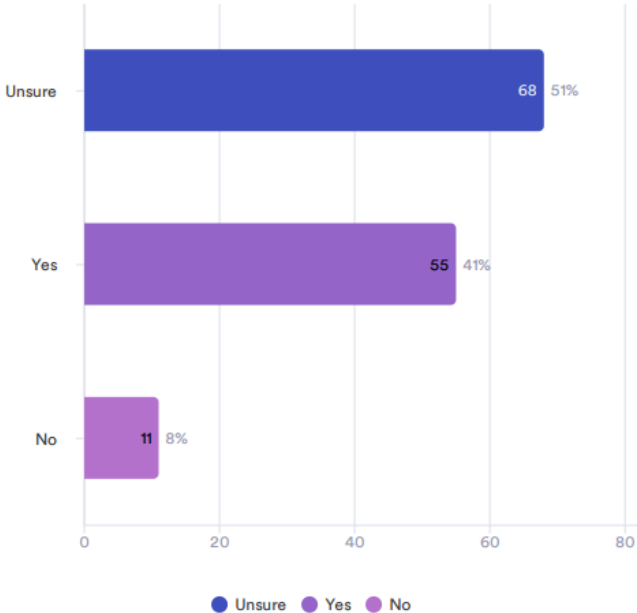
Did you attend the August long weekend entertainment with Kris Klein?

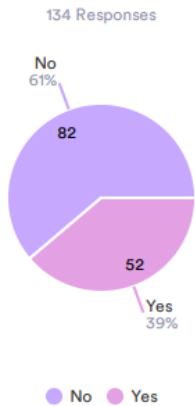
If a similar event was planned for 2024, would you plan to attend?

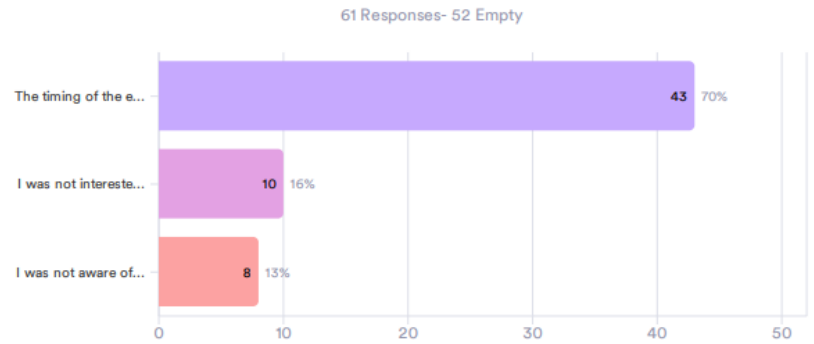

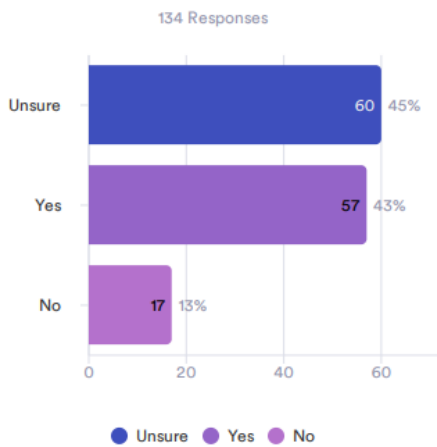
Did you attend Mistusinne Morning, May long weekend?



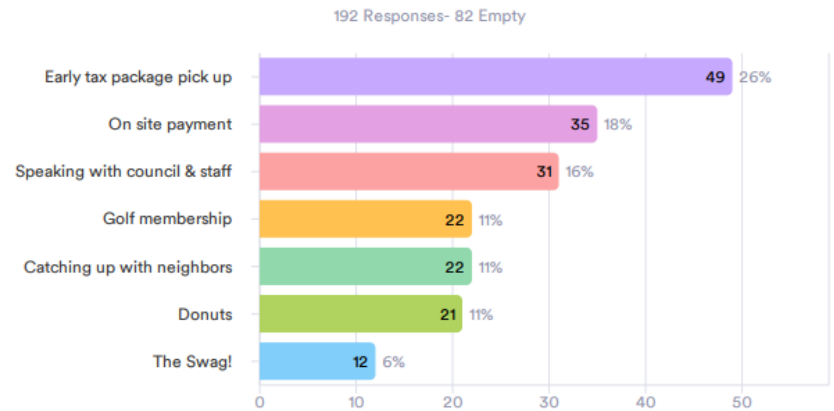
Why did you not attend?



Do you plan to attend this event in 2024?

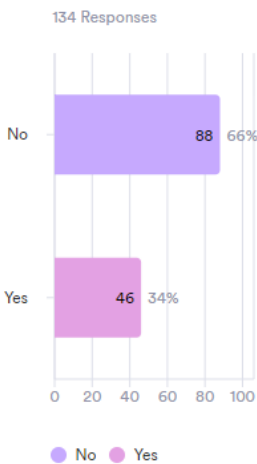


What aspects did you enjoy most about the event

Would you be willing to help water the new trees once planted?

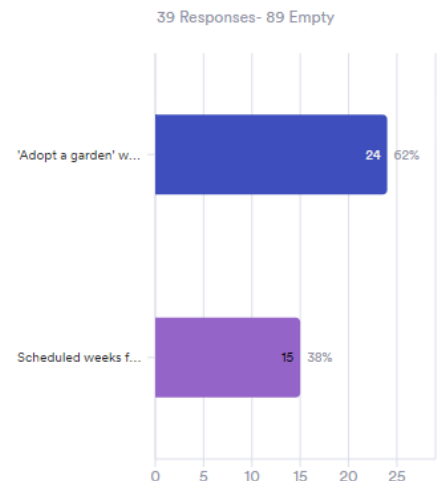

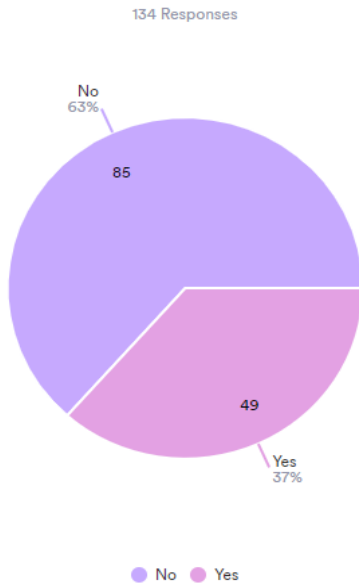

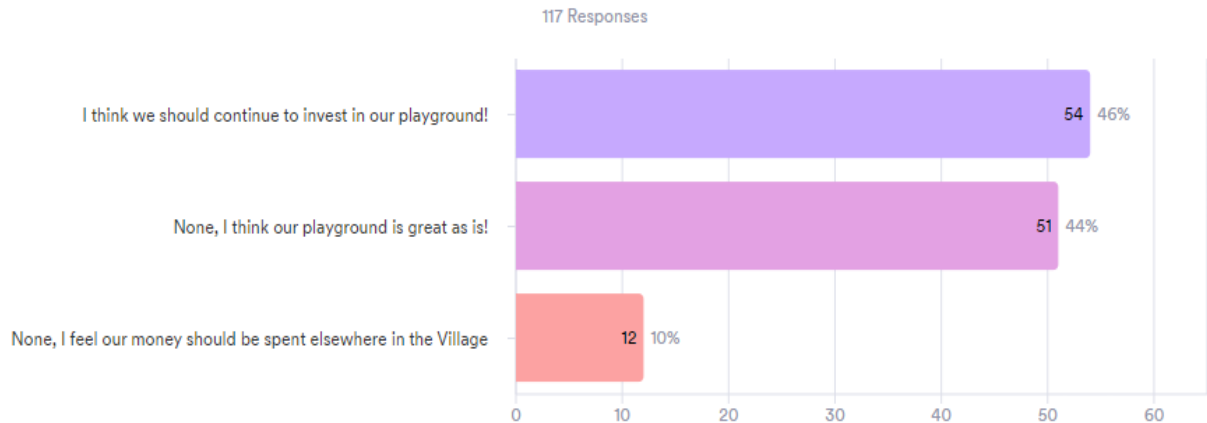
Would you like to see flower planters around the village?



Would you be willing to help maintain the planters once installed?



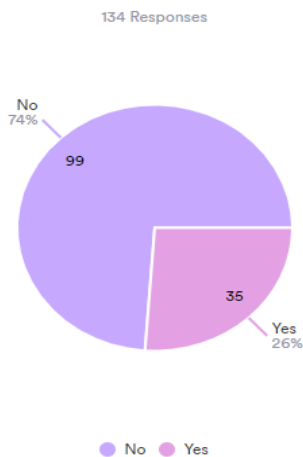
This summer our maintenance team installed a new gazebo and a 'Buddy Bus' in our playground! Are there other playground improvements would you like to see?



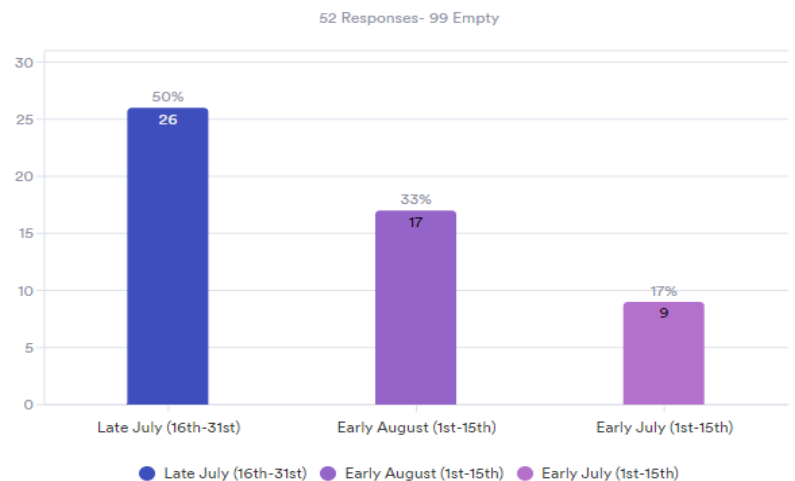

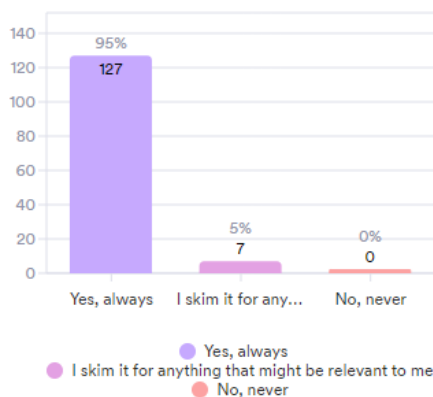

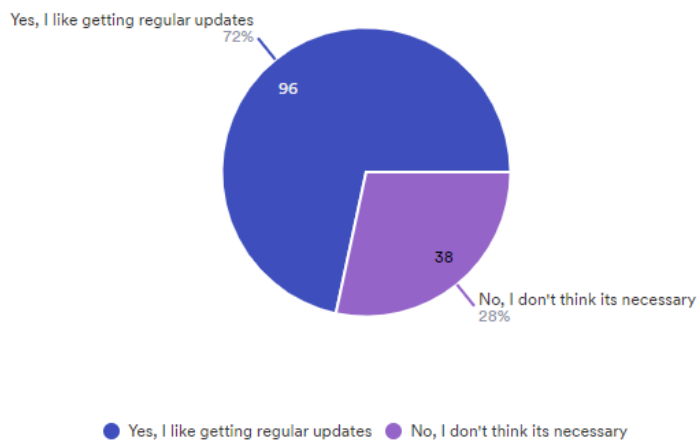

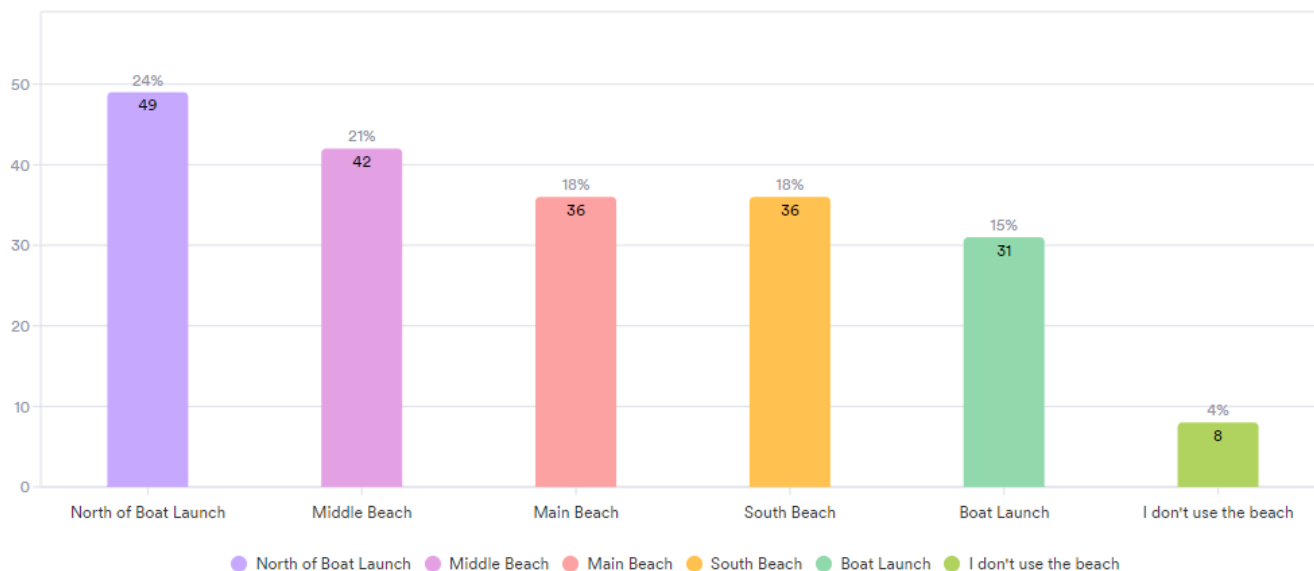

BEACHES

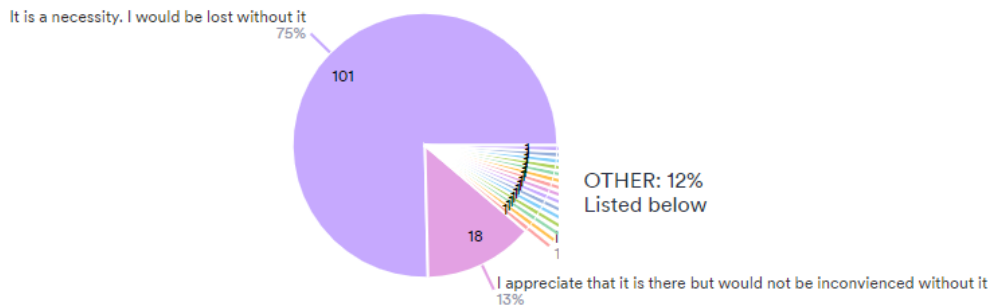
Which beach do you typically use? Please see the attached image for clarification. You may choose up to 2 options.

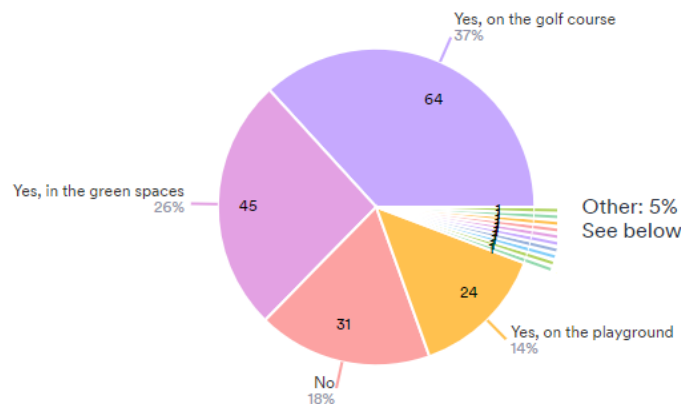


OTHER:

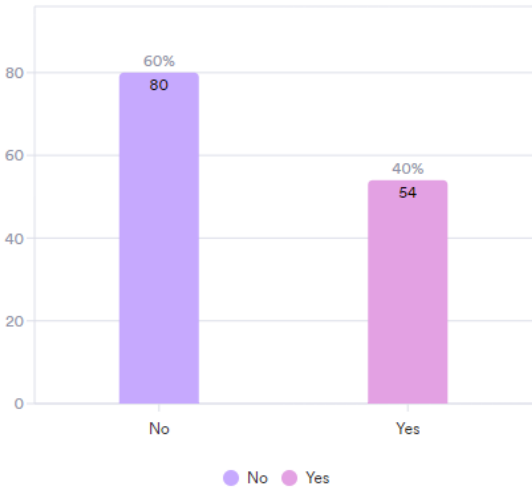
Other:

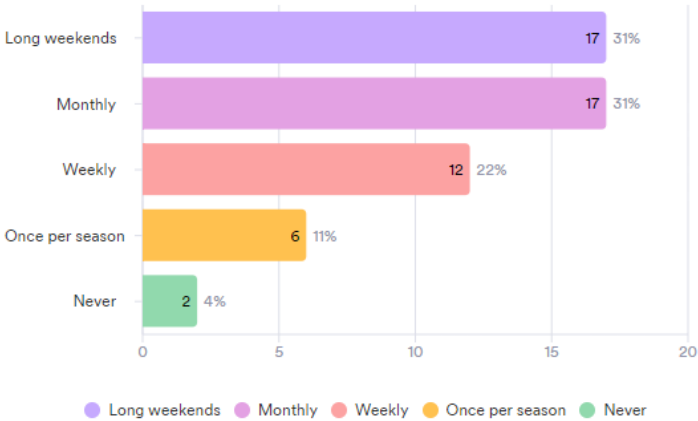
Do you feel our council should focus more on bylaw enforcement?

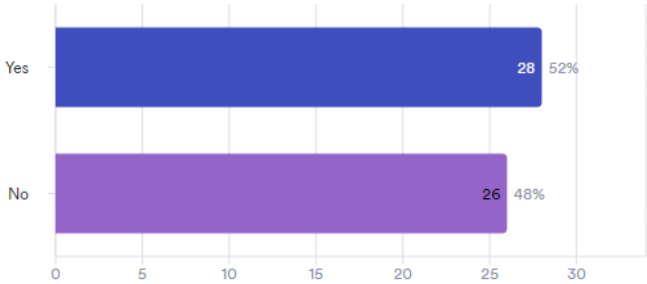
How often do you feel bylaw inspections should be scheduled

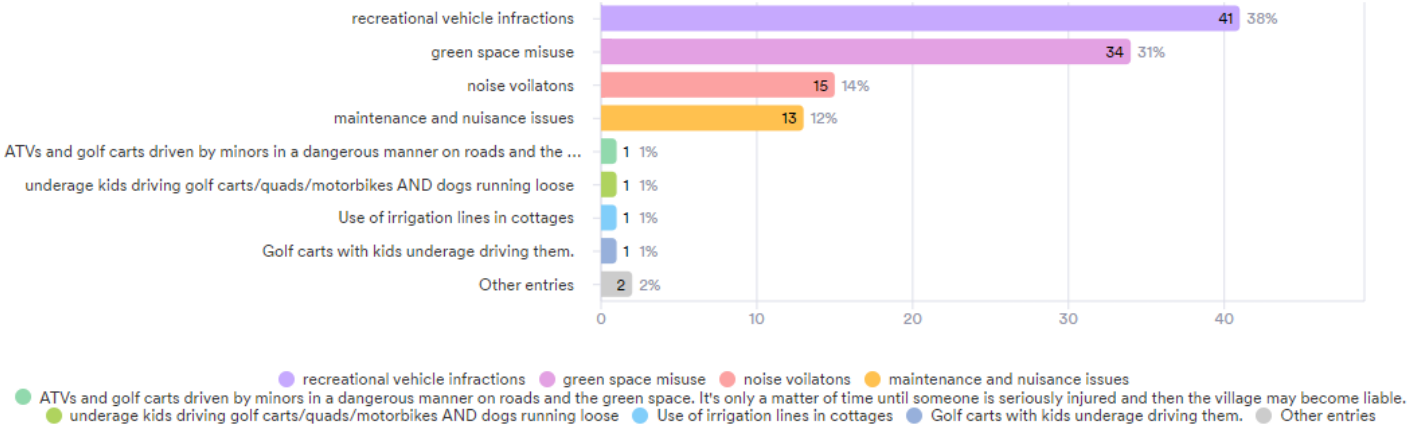
Would you be in favor of the village paying Commissionaires to provide bylaw enforcement at an approximate cost of \$80/hour?

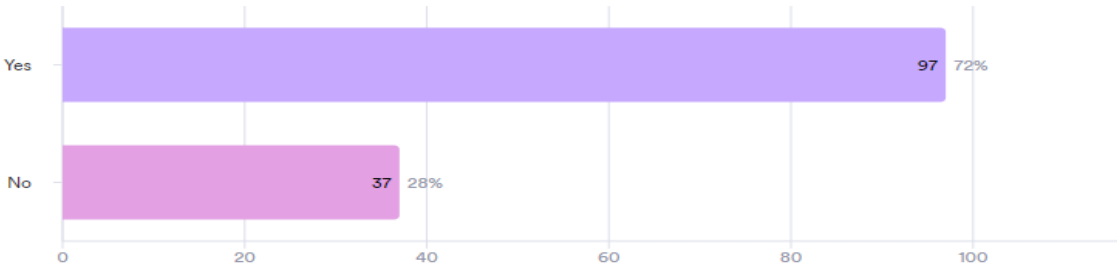
Which bylaws do you feel are the most important to focus on? (select all that apply)

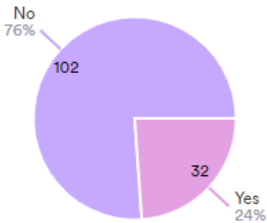
Do you think residents who misuse the garbage bins (furniture, overfilling, un-bagged, unauthorized construction material) should be fined?

Do you or your family use the Elbow Branch of Palliser Regional Library?

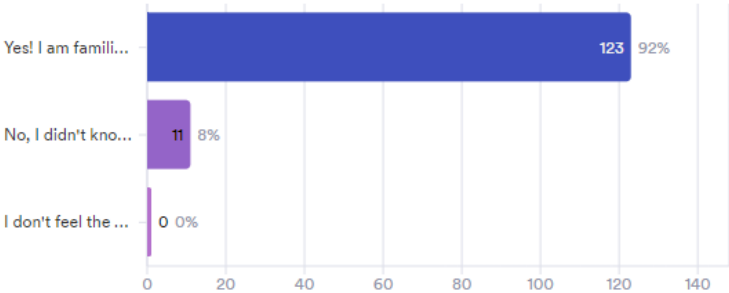
