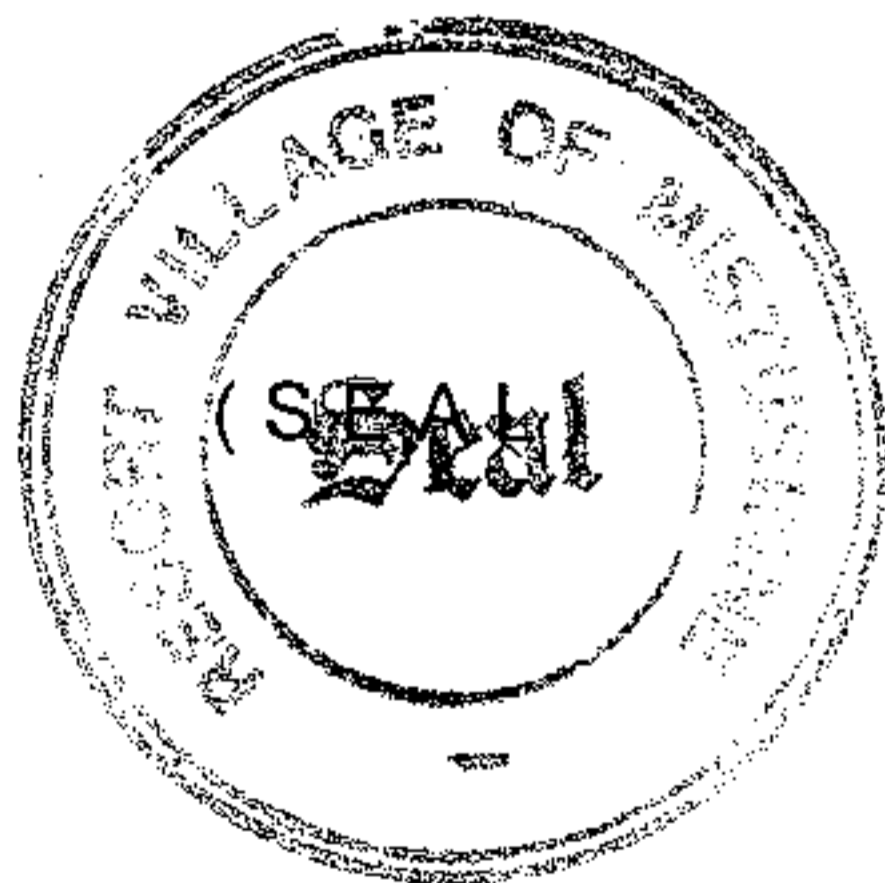



**A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES
WITHIN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF MISTUSINNE**

WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Village of Mistusinne deems it desirable to allow but regulate the use of snowmobiles within the Resort Village limits,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Resort Village of Mistusinne in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions:
 - a) "public land" means Crown land or any land vested in a municipality.
 - b) "Resort Village" means the Resort Village of Mistusinne.
 - c) "Snowmobile" means a vehicle that:
 - i) is not equipped with wheels but is equipped with tractor treads alone or with skis or with skis and a propeller; or
 - ii) is a toboggan equipped with tractor treads or a propeller; and
 - iii) is designed primarily for operating over snow and is used exclusively for that purpose; and
 - iv) is designed to be self propelled; and
 - v) does not weigh more than 500 kilograms;other than any vehicle that is designed to accommodate eight or more persons and is used for the transportation of goods or persons.
2. Snowmobiles shall be permitted to operate within the Resort Village subject to the following conditions:
 - a) All travel is to be on roadway ditches, beaches and the leased area north of the golf course.
 - b) No travel will be allowed on Resort Village leased green spaces (public land) with the exception of the leased area north of the golf course.
 - c) No person shall operate a snowmobile within the Resort Village in such a manner as to create a nuisance or undue annoyance to residents or other persons within the Resort Village.
 - d) No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any property in such a manner that is dangerous to other persons or property.
4. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and subject to a fine of \$250 per occasion.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.




