Recycling

Recycling is open 24/7. Proceeds from recycling go to the Recreation Fund.

Please remember to rinse out your containers and a reminder that everything has to be pre-sorted.

Annual Shut Offs

The irrigation water will be turned off Tuesday, October 15th. All attachments to standpipes must be removed. You may notice some interruptions in the water system prior to this date as we take care of some maintenance and upgrades.

Cabins Tied into the Water System

Please be advised that it is not permitted to tie your cabin into the water system. This is against regulations and can come with fines or dire consequences for the Municipality. NEW THIS YEAR – A form MUST be signed and kept on file with the office. Updates coming later this fall.

Sewer

No changes to the program for this year. Tanks will be checked and emptied about a week after the water is shut off. If you are opting out of a dip (using your cabin year round) please email the office as soon as possible.

Campers are allowed with an approved permit only, and for a maximum of 10 days at a time. In the spring there will be a tour conducted and all campers permanently placed on the Green Space will be towed at the owner's expense. Please relocate all units to your own property before the first snowfall. Please be advised that this year the permits applied for were low. This negatively affects all cabin owners. There are costs such as garbage associated with extra campers. If the costs continue to rise, taxes will go up. Please pay for your own guests. It's the neighbourly thing to do. Not once has administration refused a permit.
