Friendly Reminders for Our Community:

Camping Permits:

Any camper or trailer NOT on your private property must have a valid camping permit. You can get yours online, at the office, or from the RIC in the recycle room. (*Permits are valid for a maximum of 10 days*)

Motorized Vehicles:

ALL motorized vehicles (golf carts, ATVs, dirt bikes, etc.) must stay on designated roadways. Green spaces, including areas behind residences, are not for motorized travel.

Development Permits:

If you're planning to build any structure larger or longer than 10' \times 10', a Development Permit is required. Check the website for full details.

Water rate increase and bylaw change

The Resort Village has received approval from the Saskatchewan Municipal Board for the Water Rate increase submitted earlier this year. As a result, the annual irrigation water use fee has increased from \$60.00 to \$100.00 per property. Additionally, the lagoon access fee paid to the Village of Elbow remains at \$216.00. This means that the total annual service-related fee for 2025 will be \$316.00 per property, compared to the previous \$276.00. Invoices reflecting this adjustment were sent in April 11th via email.

Bylaw 01-25 reflects these changes.

This is the first increase in the irrigation water fee since implementation 12 years ago. We appreciate your cooperation as we make this necessary adjustment to ensure the sustainability and maintenance of our services. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this change, please contact the Resort Village office.

New tax discount structure for 2025

Taxes were emailed Friday, May 2nd.

We're making it easier than ever to pay your property taxes early! Starting in 2025, a new discount structure will be in place to encourage early payments and reduce administrative costs:

2025 Tax Discount Schedule

- Pay BEFORE May 31 Receive a 15% discount
- Pay BEFORE August 31 Receive a 10% discount
- Pay AFTER September 1 No discount
 PLEASE BE ADVISED THE 15% DISCOUNT ONLY APPLIES UNTIL MAY 31 THIS YEAR

Non Potable Water Agreement

Legislation does not allow for cabins to be connected to the irrigation system. This water is NOT suitable for consumption. If a cabin is connected to the system and the Water Security Agency is advised the results may be catastrophic for the individual and the community. Starting this year, EVERY CABIN must sign an agreement acknowledging these stipulations. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS. The agreements will be available in June.

Snow Removal Interested in snow removal for 2025/26? Contact the office to get on the list. Your name must be on the list prior to **SEPT 15** in order to have an appraisal. We <u>cannot</u> add names to the list after this date. Quotes are done in the fall, and invoices go out in October. It's never too early to plan ahead.

Please DO NOT pay your snow removal fees before you have been invoiced.

Council has decided to **pause irrigation expansion** for this year and focus on caring for the existing trees and green spaces.

<u>eBilling & eReceipts</u> <u>now in effect</u>

Mistusinne is now using eBilling and eReceipting to help make life easier for everyone!
