The Village has a new administrator, Kelly Dodd, who has taken over following Administrator Yvonne Jess's move to the Town of Davidson. Yvonne was with the Resort Village for 19 years and will be missed. Kelly is available by email or telephone. She also works fulltime for the Village of Dinsmore and the RM of King George No. 256. She will have regular hours in the office once her routine has been established. The Resort Village has also hired a new Maintenance Foreman, Edward Stenko and a Maintenance Assistant, Shane Clarke, who will both start in April. If you see them around please stop and introduce yourself. Leeanne Hurlburt, Administrative Assistant and Marilyn Peterson, Recycling and Office Clerk will be returning for the upcoming season.

The assessment roll for the year 2021 has been prepared. The assessment notice was mailed this week and should be in the same envelope that this newsletter came in, if you received your copy via mail. There was also a mail out provided regarding reassessments. This year is a reassessment year. Reassessment for everyone in Saskatchewan occurs every 4 years. Please review your notice and report any errors, questions or concerns to the office. If you feel you have been assessed incorrectly you may appeal for 60 days following this notice. Please contact the office well in advance of the May 29, 2021 deadline as appeals cannot be processed in 1 day. The cost is \$200.00 per property. You will be refunded if your appeal is successful.

Golf Carts & ATVs – There will be new procedures in place this year regarding Golf Cart and ATV use. All persons utilizing golf carts in the Village must have their Cabin Number on the back-right fender of their cart. Stickers have been made by the Village for this purpose. They will be handed out at the May long weekend meeting or you can pick yours up at the Office. Council has been working diligently throughout the Winter months along with the local RCMP to come up with guidelines for Golf Carts and ATV use in the Village. The plan is to hold a parent/rate payer information meeting on the May long weekend. Please watch for further information on May long weekend meetings.

The Resort Village has been approached by a company who provides high speed internet services. Council and administration are interested in knowing which cabins do not have internet service currently, and which cabins may be interested in exploring this new opportunity further should it become an option. If you are looking for internet services currently and would like more information please contact the office to be added to the list. We will provide more information should there be enough interest.

Quads on the Beach – please note that quads are not allowed on the beach between Douglas Park and the boat launch between April 1 and October 31 (unless you have received a handicap plate from the Office).

Council is still researching dock options for the boat launch. We are in the process of having a professional conceptual study completed to ensure we find a suitable option.

The RCMP has informed Council that break and enters are up in the area and asked that ratepayers be made aware of this.

The Village would like to take this opportunity to thank Saskatchewan Lotteries for their yearly grants for recreation projects. Last year they supported the purchase of a soccer/hockey net to be installed on the tennis court and upgrades to the basketball net. This year they will be supporting the purchase of a volleyball net to be set up north of the middle beach and left of the boat launch road. Watch for it this Spring.

Last Summer the Office received a number of complaints regarding noise (from parties, fires, etc.) that was happening later into the night. Please respect your fellow neighbors and remember that quiet time should be observed after 10:00 pm. Check out the noise bylaw on the website for more information.

Council will be hiring a summer student for months of July and August again this Summer. The student generally does grass mowing, clean-up, watering, weeding and other jobs assigned by the Maintenance Foreman. If you are interested watch for posters or check out the website later this Spring.

The Village is looking for a volunteer coordinator to do the organizing for Canada Day this year. As mentioned above a grant has been received to help with the celebrations. If you are interested in taking on this task or helping with this event please contact the Office.

Please remember that **all items** must be removed from storage in the Maintenance Yard by April 30. If you would like to be in the lotto for a storage space this year please pick up the form at the Office or ask for it to be emailed to you. The lotto draw for spaces will take place at the May meeting. There will only be 50 spaces available and the cost for a space will be \$100.
